Singapore, 27 October 2009 - Selected tourist attractions of Singapore and Indonesia will be featured on the joint stamp issue of Singapore Post (SingPost) and Pos Indonesia to be released tomorrow. There are four stamp designs and one Miniature Sheet for this stamp issue. This is the first major collaboration between SingPost and Pos Indonesia.



Priced at S\$2.81, this set of four commemorative stamps depicts the Merlion, the Sentosa, Singa Ambara Raja Statue and Taman Mini Indonesia Indah. The limited edition commemorative cover (S\$5.95), which consists of stamps from both Singapore and Indonesia, is only available on 28 October 2009, making it a collector's item.

Also available on sale are the Pre-cancelled First Day Cover affixed with the complete set of stamps (S\$3.65), Pre-cancelled First Day Cover affixed with Miniature Sheet (S\$3.65) and the Presentation Pack (S\$4.60).

This stamp issue will be launched at the Club Islander, located at the Palawan Beach in Sentosa, on 28 October at noon by Minister-Counsellor, Mr Kemal Haripurwanto, Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia, in the presence of officials from Infocomm Development Authority of Singapore (IDA) and SingPost.

The complete set of stamps, first day covers and presentation pack will be on sale from 28 October at all post offices and the Singapore Philatelic Museum. Orders can also be made at SingPost's online shopping portal, vPOST at <http://shop.vpost.com.sg>.
